The SDE will make strong artistic contributions to the success of our youth productions by serving as Director and/or Choreographer.

Responsibilities:

- Serve as liaison and advocate for the Education Department during staff and production meetings
- Maintain regular and effective communication with parents/caregivers
- Create and maintain daily camp schedule
- Assist in creating and executing camp/program curricula for students ages 6-15 y/o
- Direct/Choreograph summer youth productions

Qualifications:

- Ideal candidates are early to mid-career TYA professionals with at least 5 years of experience as a teaching artist
- Fluency in Spanish or ESL a plus
- In accordance with national standards and practices, all potential SDE's are subject to a federal background check
